Privacy Policy

At The Margaret Adcock Foundation, we are committed to safeguarding your personal information and respecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, and protect the data you provide when using our services, particularly when submitting information via our web form.

1. Who We Are

The Margaret Adcock Foundation is a registered charity in the United Kingdom (Charity Registration Number 1205889). The foundation was created with three aims: To provide financial assistance to families of children newly diagnosed with cancer; To support disadvantaged children and young adults in the Philippines, by funding school/university fees in partnership with established charities; To fund research into treatments for alveolar rhabdomyosarcoma in collaboration with cancer charities and official funding channels. 2. Information We Collect

We collect the following personal information when you fill out our web forms:

- Contact Information: Name, date of birth, postal address.
- Bank Account Details: For payment processing, including grant disbursements.
- Health Information: Specific health-related details relevant to your application (e.g., medical conditions or diagnoses).

We only collect the information necessary to process your application and deliver our services effectively.

3. How We Use Your Information

The information you provide is used for the following purposes:

- To assess and process grant applications.
- To communicate with you regarding your application or our services.
- To comply with legal obligations and reporting requirements.

Health and financial data are treated with heightened sensitivity and used only where strictly necessary, in accordance with applicable laws.

4. Legal Basis for Processing

We process your personal data under the following legal bases:

- Consent: When you provide explicit consent for us to collect and use your personal data.
- Legitimate Interests: To fulfil our charitable objectives and manage your application.
- Legal Obligations: To comply with UK law and regulatory requirements.

5. How We Protect Your Data

We take data security seriously and have implemented appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your information. These include:

- Secure servers and encryption protocols for data transmission.
- Restricted access to sensitive information, limited to authorized personnel.
- Regular security audits to maintain compliance with data protection laws.

6. Sharing Your Information

We will only share your information:

- With trusted third parties, such as payment processors or partner organizations, to facilitate your application.
- Where required by law, such as with regulatory authorities.

We will never sell or share your data with third parties for marketing purposes.

7. Your Rights

Under the UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018, you have the following rights:
